<u>RULES GOVERNING APPLICATIONS FOR THE AWARD OF</u> <u>AN LICENTIATE OF THE IAC (LACI)</u> <u>(for Audio-Visual producers)</u> (An alternative application form is available for Video Makers)

- 1) This distinction is granted by the IAC Council for attainment in audio-visual arts.
- Applications should be made in writing to the Fellowships Officer on the official form, enclosing £4 nonreturnable administration cost.
- 3) Applicants must be full individual or principal family members of the IAC. If you are not at present a FULL member of the IAC, this application can still be validated subject to you joining as a Full member within eight weeks of the close of the Peter Coles A-V Competition. Please return membership application form to the IAC Office (address above) and a cheque to cover the full membership fee. Associate members wishing to transfer to full membership should contact Head Office for details.
- 4) To qualify, applicants must have accumulated at least two points as follows. Two A-V sequences which have each won two awards (These can be either International awards or awards at the National AV Championships) will be worth one point provided that one of these awards was via the Peter Coles / Geoffrey Round A-V Competition. This method of accumulating points will need to be repeated twice. (4 sequences and 8 awards are required in total, with a minimum of 2 of these awards being gained via the Peter Coles / Geoffrey Round A-V Competition.) Documentary evidence of these awards may be required.
- 5) Each A-V sequence must have been made in the name of the applicant in the role of the producer. Club entries will not count. Each sequence may be used by one applicant only.
- 6) All sequences to be covered by appropriate copyright licences.
- 7) To ensure this is adhered to, the Fellowships Officer will keep a full and careful catalogue of all applications.
- 8) If an applicant is successful the Fellowship will remain in force only as long as the holder possesses a currently valid IAC subscription receipt.
- 9) Successful applicants may style themselves as Licentiate of the IAC Film and Video Institute (LACI)
- 10) It is the responsibility of the Fellowships Officer to ensure that all rules and regulations are scrupulously observed. Also that all reports and correspondence are treated with due expediency and confidentiality.
- 11) In the event of any dispute the Fellowships Officer's decision is final.
